America Saves Week is an annual opportunity in April encouraging Americans to take control of their money and commit to saving. This year, focus on your financial story and consider the small steps that you can take now to have a big impact on your future.



Maximize Your Match

If you are a member of the Hybrid Retirement Plan, make sure you are contributing the voluntary maximum of 4% to your Hybrid 457 Plan. Doing so will get you the full 2.5% match from your employer.

Consider saving in the Commonwealth of Virginia 457 Deferred Compensation Plan. For salaried employees of the Commonwealth of Virginia, the matching amount is 50% of your contribution to the COV 457 Deferred Compensation Plan, not to exceed \$20 per pay period. Political subdivisions and school divisions that participate in the Virginia Cash Match Plan may establish their own match amount. Wage employees are not eligible for the employer cash match. If you are a Hybrid Retirement Plan member, you must first maximize your voluntary contributions into the Hybrid 457 Plan before receiving the employer match in the Virginia Cash Match Plan.

To increase your contributions,

log in to your account, at dcp.varetire.org/login, choose your plan, click Contributions & Savings, then Manage Contributions.

Review Your Beneficiaries

Designate your beneficiaries and keep them updated. Doing so helps ensure your account assets will be distributed as you desire in the event of your death. Periodically review your designations and make updates in the event of life changes such as marriage, the birth of a child or divorce.
